Julia in Year 5 (Group 3) is our Star of the Week. She has been very enthusiastic and engaged, creating art work based

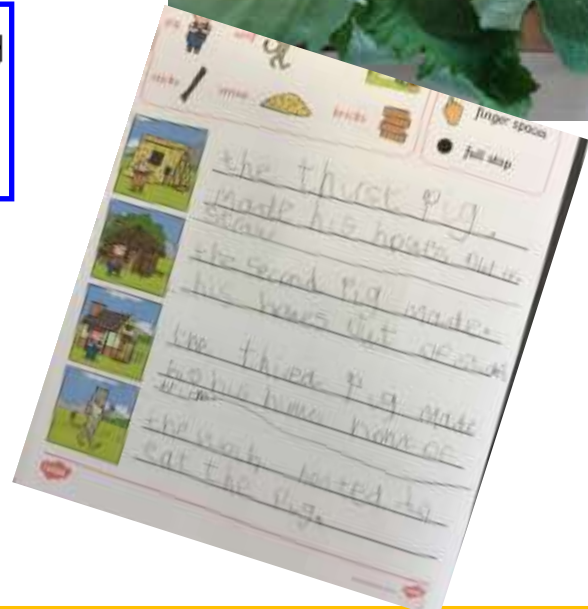
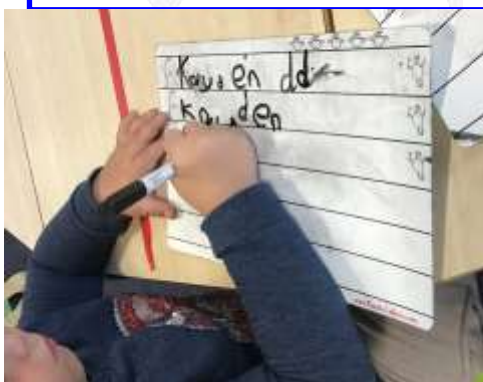

Forest floor

Understory

Emergent layer

These giant trees that stick out above the canopy makes emergent layer. Birds like hawks, eagles, parrots, bats and insects lives there.
